COMMENTS FROM THE BOARD:

EAST STUART

Ryan Strom questioned liability regarding civic space requirements on private property.

Campbell Rich asked Jessica Seymour to expand on the benefits of moving to a form-based code.

Jessica Seymour said that the impact of the form-based code will be correcting uses for flexible housing types in East Stuart, and assist in making the process streamlined. In the Creek District there is hesitance as to what they can build and this will provide the tools for residents and developers to know what they can do with the land.

Pinal Gandhi-Savdas explained the future goals for the form-based code.

Discussion continued about civic open space recommendations.

THE CREEK DISTRICT

Bill Mathers asked about existing bulk heads for seaswalls and his concern about non-conforming uses.

Jessica Seamour clarified she does not think there are any for current residents, but would follow up.

The board discussed planning for parking.

Bill Mathers expanded on the Comprehensive Plan and planning for non-conforming uses.

The board discussed thoroughfare standards and street types.

Mike Mortell explained that throughout the years and workshops the public gave feedback that they would like a form-based code concept.

Jessica Seymour said that they worked with staff and the commission to implement formbased code in the Creek District and East Stuart first based on need.

Discussion occurred about similar form-based code examples and how the City should move forward.

Ryan Strom spoke about concerns that he would like to address in the allowances.

Jessica Seymour addressed his concerns.

Erin Wohlitka and Mike Mortell continued to give examples of successful form-based codes.

The process for approval was discussed.
